

# True-to-Scale Curtain Cutting Diagram (Revised)

Scale: 1 inch = 6 inches of fabric

Fabric width: 54 inches

Total yardage: 12 yards (432 inches)

Panel cut length: 86 inches

Finished length: ~79.5–80 inches

Header: 2.5 inches | Bottom hem: 4 inches

| Cut Order | Piece Size (W × L) | Purpose                               |
|-----------|--------------------|---------------------------------------|
| 1         | 54" × 86"          | Area 3 – Panel 1 base                 |
| 2         | 54" × 86"          | Area 3 – Panel 2 base                 |
| 3         | 54" × 86"          | Area 1 & 2 base                       |
| 4         | 54" × 86"          | Area 1 & 2 base                       |
| 5         | 54" × 86"          | Side strips (cut into two 14" strips) |

## Assembly Notes:

- Cut five 86" drops in sequence (total used: 430")
- Drop #5 is sub-cut into two 14" × 86" strips
- Area 3 panels = 54" + 14" (2 pieces per panel)
- Area 1 & 2 panels are trimmed to ~40" width
- Place seams toward walls for best appearance
